SPECTATOR INFIELD PARKING

Spectator vehicle parking in the infield is \$25. The parking spaces are reserved. The person that had a reserved space at the 2010 Henry County Fair Demolition Derby may pay for that space until the office closes on Thursday, August 11 at 7 p.m. After that time the remaining spaces will be available on a first come, first serve basis. No glass containers, please. There is a maximum of one set of scaffolding. Infield parking begins at 2 p.m. on Thursday.

2011 PIT PASS RULES

1. Each driver can have a three person crew, and those three people and the driver will be the only people allowed in the pit area.
2. The driver must list the names of their three person crew when registering and each person on the registration form must go to the fair office to pick up their pit pass and sign a release form, before entering the pit area.
3. Any person entering the pit area during the demolition derby must be at least 18 years old.
4. A pit pass must be presented to enter and visible when in the pit area.
5. All pull-out trucks will have a maximum of 4 people per truck, and anyone riding in a pull-out truck must go to the fair office to pick up a pit pass and sign a release form, before entering the pit area. Pit passes are \$15.

BLIND HEAT

1. Entries will be limited to the first ten drivers to sign up.
2. Driver and Co-driver must both sign release forms.
3. There will be a 30 minute time limit.
4. If more than one vehicle is left running the winner will be chosen by a panel of judges and/or the peoples choice.
5. Seat belts must be installed for both the driver and the co-driver.
6. Helmets must be worn by both the driver and the co-driver.
7. All other Henry County Fair Demolition Derby Rules apply.

Additional safety regulations may be imposed depending on track. Titles must be turned in on all vehicles or left for junk. These rules subject to change without notice according to the committee.
